Icebreaker Questions

- What is one of your pet peeves?

Read Matthew 24:9-14

- What are some questions that come to mind after reading this passage?
- What does it mean that he who endures to the end will be saved (Matthew 24:13)?

Read verses 9-10

- What does tribulation look like for Christians in today's world?
- What do you picture tribulation looking like for Christians in the End Times?
- NKJV translates "fall away" as "offended" - how does this shape your understanding of this verse?
- What does it look like within the church to be offended?
- Why is being offended so dangerous?

Read verses 11-12

- What would a false prophet look like locally within our own church?
- Why would lawlessness create someone's love to grow cold?
- What would it look like if our church's love grew cold?
- What would a church look like if it's love were hot?

Read verses 13-14

- What advice would you give to another person about being prepared to endure to the end?
- How do we live in the tension as believers that we are supposed to actively proclaim Christ to the world, while we know that God has already predestined it to happen?

- What is an action that you can begin to implement today or tomorrow?
- What is going to be the most difficult aspect of this study to personally apply?
