Angel - Messenger sent from God.

Psalm 103:20 Bless the Lord, O you his angels, you mighty ones who do his word, obeying the voice of his word!

Hebrews 12:22 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, and to innumerable angels in festal gathering

Who are these Angels?

Created beings

Colossians 1:16 For by him all things were created, in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or rulers or authorities—all things were created through him and for him.

Psalm 148:1-6 You are the LORD, you alone. You have made heaven, the heaven of heavens, with all their host.

• Personal beings

Mark 16:5 And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, dressed in a white robe, and they were alarmed.

• Holy Ones

Daniel 8:13 Then I heard a holy one speaking, and another holy one said to the one who spoke, "For how long is the vision concerning the regular burnt offering, the transgression that makes desolate, and the giving over of the sanctuary and host to be trampled underfoot?"

- They do not die
- Have emotions and will
- They don't marry

Matthew 22:30 For in the resurrection they neither marry nor are given in marriage, but are like angels in heaven.

• They don't have bodies

Hebrews 1:13-14 And to which of the angels has he ever said, "Sit at my right hand until I make your enemies a footstool for your feet"? Are they not all ministering spirits sent out to serve for the sake of those who are to inherit salvation?

Powerful beings

II Peter 2:11 whereas angels, though greater in might and power, do not pronounce a blasphemous judgment against them before the Lord.

Three angels are named in the Bible

- 1. Lucifer
- 2. Michael the archangel

Jude 1:9 But when the archangel Michael, contending with the devil, was disputing about the body of Moses, he did not presume to pronounce a blasphemous judgment, but said, "The Lord rebuke you."

3. Gabriel

Luke 1:26-38 In the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent from God... But she was greatly troubled at the saying... And the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid... And Mary said to the angel, "How..... And the angel answered her, "The Holy Spirit...

Groups of Angels

- 1. Cherubim
- 2. Seraphim

Isaiah 6:6-7 Then one of the seraphim flew to me, having in his hand a burning coal that he had taken with tongs from the altar. And he touched my mouth and said: "Behold, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away, and your sin atoned for."

God through angels does powerful things.

Hebrews 1:14 Are they not all ministering spirits sent out to serve for the sake of those who are to inherit salvation?

Hebrews 13:2 Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by so doing some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing

Do our deceased loved ones become angels?

Do we have guardian angels?

Matthew 18:10 "See that you do not despise one of these little ones. For I tell you that in heaven their angels always see the face of my Father who is in heaven."

Acts 27:23-24 For this very night there stood before me an angel of the God to whom I belong and whom I worship, and he said, 'Do not be afraid, Paul; you must stand before Caesar. And behold, God has granted you all those who sail with you.'
