KINGDOM DOWN, NOT CULTURE UP!

KEY BIBLE PASSAGE: Matthew 6:5-15

DISCUSSION:

- What pain are you observing in the people around you?
- How are those people addressing their hurt?
- Take specific lines in the Lord's prayer and think through how they can address specific hurts you listed.
- Read Matthew 6:5-8
 - List the 3 warnings that Jesus gives in these verses.
 - How have you experienced these 3 things in your personal life and church background.
- Why do we pray these things when nothing ever seems to change. (v..8)
- The Lord's prayer is broken up into relationship, reverence, submission, and dependence. Which one of these do you need most as you pray today? (v.5-15)
- What does a "God's Kingdom" prayer look like? How is it different than a "self kingdom" prayer? (v.10-13)
- Explain what "forgave and forgive" means in your life. (v14-15)
